

## Hospitality at St Paul's

St Paul's is a community dedicated to the way of our Lord Jesus Christ. We offer hospitality at our services to all who wish to join us in that pilgrimage.

Greeters welcome every person as he or she comes into the church. Everyone is offered a hymn book and a bulletin that provides full details of the liturgy, enabling everyone to participate fully in the worship.



During the course of the service we all recognize our fellowship in Christ by exchanging the peace, moving freely about the church to do so.

With very few exceptions, our services are celebrations of the Eucharist (or Holy Communion) in which we share the bread and wine which are the body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ.

All baptized Christians are invited to receive Communion in our church. Alternatively, any one may choose to receive a blessing. The bulletin describes how Communion and blessings are administered at each service.

Visitors are invited to sign the Visitors' Book at the back of the church. Pew cards are available for any newcomer who wishes to learn more about our community. The greeters are also glad to give information.

Following most Sunday services, hosts serve coffee and refreshments in the lower hall, inviting everyone to join them.



From time to time we have picnics and other social events. All guests at our church are invited to join us.

Every Thursday the parish priest invites everyone to join him in the King Room at a brown-bag lunch.
